

# INSTRUCTIONS

Please bear in mind that computer-based training/learning in VA computer networks is not without problems (i.e., access, speed and connectivity to TMS courses, BLS/ACLS eLearning, etc.) so accessing the mandatory courses now is not unwise. *As you establish your new learning accounts (instructions provided below), use your most commonly used LOGIN information for both HealthStream and Oridion so you can easily remember. Always print 2 certificates of training for every lesson you complete (for your NM and your very own record). You are REQUIRED to present your certificates of training before the start of your training sessions. Thank you!*

## A) HealthStream for the Alaris IV pumps & modules

### PLEASE FOLLOW THESE STEPS

- Go to [learn.healthstream.com/accesspoint/alaris](https://learn.healthstream.com/accesspoint/alaris)
- Choose the country and the state in which your facility is located.
- From the list, choose your facility (**VA Medical Center- Durham**) and click the 'Next' button at the bottom of the screen.
- Click First time students click here to register and complete the account registration form. *(ICU staff who recently accessed HealthStream for CRRT module, please use the same login info).*
- Click **Submit**
- Click the **HospitalDirect** tab
- Find the **Alaris® System and IV Sets and Accessories - Module Specific** (DO NOT choose the Basic version) course listing (or search in the catalog)
  1. RN and LPN will enter code 42
  2. Respiratory will enter code 59

### PLEASE FOLLOW THESE STEPS

1. Go to [www.capnographyeducation.com](http://www.capnographyeducation.com)
  2. Select a language (English, Français, español, 日本語)
  3. "Request New Account", by clicking the "login" link
  4. Be sure to fill in all \*Required Fields. Please be sure to remember your username and password
