## 2011-12 CSC Trip Announcement

For the ninth year in a row, the club will go to **Breckenridge** in December. The bus will leave Wednesday evening, December 7, 2011, for three days of skiing. Depart Saturday evening (after skiing) and arrive in Lincoln Sunday morning, December 11.

**Crested Butte** is the destination with the Flatland Ski Association this season. The bus will leave Lincoln Tuesday evening, Jan. 24, 2012. The board hasn't decided if we will stay over Saturday night. If you have strong thoughts either way, let a board member or trip coordinator know. Our last trip to this great destination was in January, 2000 and there have been many changes at the resort. There are new meeting and lodging facilities along with mountain run changes. This will be a great trip to ski a renovated resort area.

**Beaver Creek** Resort is our third destination . At this time, it will be a "find your own transportation" trip so lodging will begin on Sunday, March 4, 2012, with checkout on Friday, March 9. There will be a 4-day lift ticket included for Beaver Creek, Arrowhead and Vail. We will be staying at the Seasons at Avon. There is a gondola to the top of Beaver Creek just a short walk away from the 2-bedroom condos or a bus available to transport you to the base area. Lodging has shopping, grocery store and restaurants nearby so it will be easy to get out in the evening. A bus will be considered if there is enough interest.
