Early Sign up Discount!!! — The CSC Board is offering early sign-up discounts using October 1, 2012, as the deadline to inspire members to sign up earlier for trips. Cornhusker Ski Club members can save \$50.00 by signing up with a deposit for Crested Butte or the bus to Snowmass by October 1.

This early sign-up discount is available on the December CSC Crested Butte trip and on the CSC bus trip to Snowmass in January 2013.

New Member Discounts!! — The Board instituted a new member discount for the 2012-2013 trips in addition to the early sign up discount. **New members** will receive a one-time \$25 discount on any trip they sign up for in the current ski season. A \$25 discount coupon will be issued for a new single membership and two \$25 coupons for a new family membership. **The trip coupons can only be used on the CSC led ski trips to Crested Butte in December, 2012, and Snowmass bus trip in January, 2013.** The coupons will include the new member/family member name and are not transferable. These coupons can be used in addition to taking advantage of the “early sign up discounts” if the new members become CSC members and sign-up for a trip by October 1.

December ski/board trip has a new destination...Crested Butte with a price so low you won't be able to resist signing up!

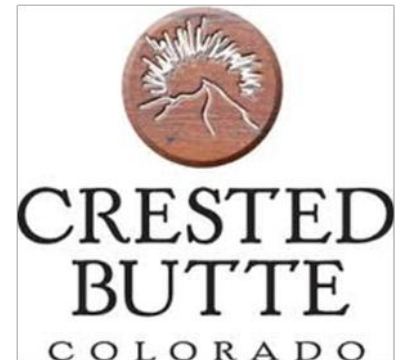

No worries regarding snow in December as they have 282 acres of snowmaking on the green & blue runs. There are two express lifts to carry you up the mountain quickly each morning. Base area altitude is 9,375 feet. CSC skied at Crested Butte last January for the FSA races & activities and had a great time at the mountain skiing, snowshoeing, enjoying the restaurants and shops at the mountain and in the historic town of Crested Butte.

—Sign up by October 1 and you will get an early sign-up discount. (See article elsewhere in this newsletter in regards to pricing this season.)

—Price includes overnight bus transportation and two nights of minimum occupancy lodging at the Plaza Condominiums along with a pizza party! Our lodging is just across a parking lot from the lifts and an easy walk to the restaurants and stores. The spacious condos at the Plaza will be minimum occupancy which means **no one has to use the sleeper sofas!**

—Sleeper bus leaves Lincoln Wednesday evening, December 12. Ski dates will be December 13, 14, and 15 with a departure after skiing to return to Lincoln Sunday, December 16.
