## CRESTED BUTTE---2<sup>nd</sup> BUS POSSIBILITY December 12 – 16, 2012

The Cornhusker Ski Club board has secured a possible second bus for Crested Butte. The cheap price of this three days of skiing has generated so much interest that the board wants to offer it to as many members as we can. So, sign up **NOW** to make the bus happen—we need 30 participants and already have a good start towards that number!

The trip price includes:

- **Transportation** by sleeper bus from Lincoln. We can pick up participants along I-80. Leave Lincoln Wednesday evening, December 12 and arrive back in Lincoln Sunday, Dec. 16.
- **Lodging** at The Plaza for two nights (2-bedroom minimum occupancy condos, just a short walk from the lifts, dining and shopping),
- **Three (3) days of lift tickets**, (lift tickets December 13 – 15, 2012)
- **Pizza party** the first night at the condos.

## CSC Bus Trip to FSA... Snowmass and Aspen, CO: FSA January, 2013

Welcome to Snowmass along with three other mountains on one lift ticket! Woodbridge Condos is our destination in Snowmass to celebrate another season of racing and partying with the other Flatland Ski Association clubs. Snowmass advertises 4,406 vertical feet, 3,132 acres of terrain, 91 trails, 21 chairlifts, and access to your choice of cruisers, glades, steeps, terrain parks and halfpipes. If that isn't enough terrain to keep you happy, grab the bus to go to Aspen Mt., Aspen Highlands, or Buttermilk, which will be hosting the X-games while we are there.

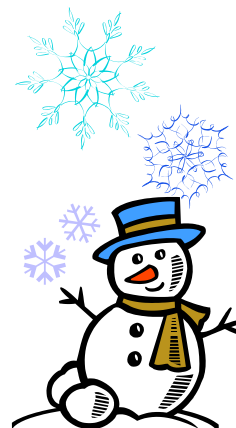

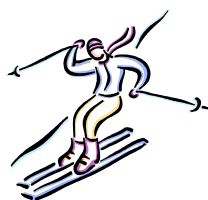

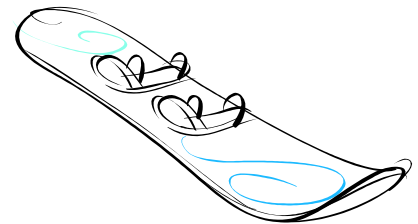
