What are the responsibilities and rewards of being a trip captain for a CSC trip?

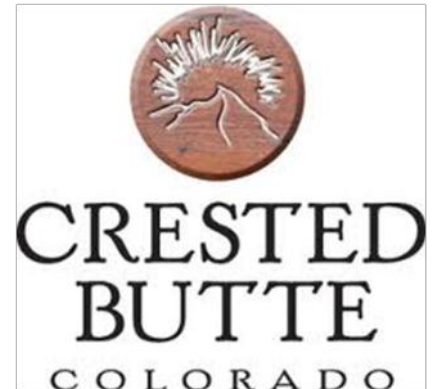
- An opportunity to lead fellow skiers/boarders to a ski destination and earn credits toward the trip.

Meetings are held on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Tuesday of the month at Parker’s Smokehouse in Lincoln.
- Responsibilities include advertising the trip, tracking applicants and payments, writing an article for the monthly newsletter, hosting a pre-trip party and/or setting up a pizza party at the destination resort, final information sheet, room list, and other leadership opportunities that arise.
- Be the contact person at the resort to solve any problems.
- Assist in securing equipment for any ski/board renters at the mountain.

**THIRD TRIP STILL IN PLANNING STAGES:** More information will be provided as decisions are made by the board.



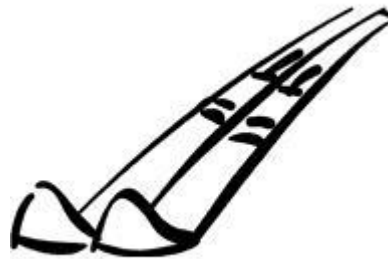
