

Directions: (2361 Wittstruck Road). Take Highway 77 south Wittstruck is about 2 miles south of Satillo Road. Turn left (east).



DECEMBER CSC TO COPPER MOUNTAIN!!!!!

Yes, CSC members, we have a new destination for the annual December trip-COPPER MOUNTAIN!! This special information is being released early due to an opportunity for discounted lift tickets. **Trip info, trip captain and sign up will follow later this summer.**

SKI DATES: Friday, December 12 – Monday, December 15. Yes, four days of skiing/boarding!! Depart Thursday evening, December 11, and return early Tuesday morning, December 16.

SPECIAL LIFT TICKET OPPORTUNITY: Purchase a 4-pack ski pass direct from Copper Mountain by Monday, June 23, 5:00 p.m. CT on your own for \$149.00!!! You will be able to ski all 4 days for that rate. OPTIONAL: You can choose to not take advantage of this offer and buy tickets through the club for \$55.00 per day, i.e. 3 days=\$165.00, 4 days=\$220.00 later this year. So you can see that the four-pack saves you money for either 3 or 4 days of skiing.

The 4-pack is nontransferable and you will have your picture taken at the mountain when we arrive to tie yourself to the 4-pack.

The early-bird trip cost with no lift tickets will be \$345 and includes bus transportation, 3 nights of condo lodging at Copper Mountain, pizza party the first night, and bus beverages. The trip WITH the 4-pack & club will cost you \$494.00 vs. a 4 day lift ticket early-signup trip price of \$565.00 buying the tickets later, saving you \$71.00 along with the opportunity to renew the 4-pack for the next year.
