- If you wish to go and do not ski, minus \$190 lift ticket price.



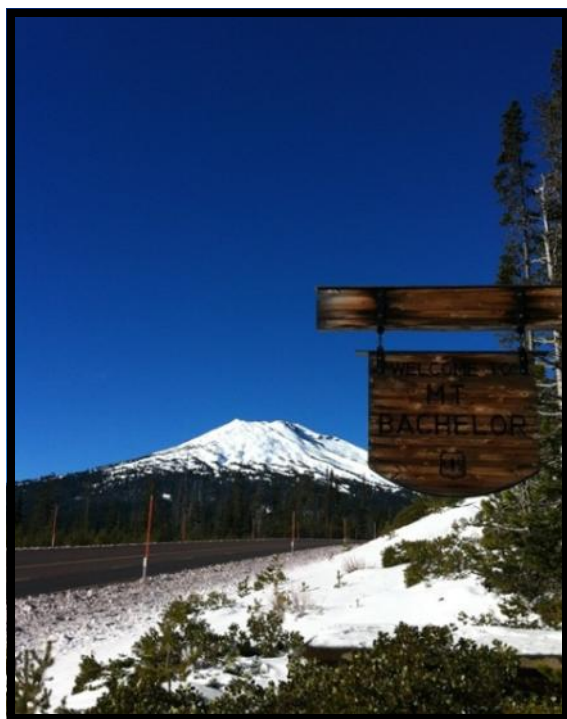
Sign-up early as this trip will sell out and it is not known whether we will be able to get additional rooms. Prices subject to change.

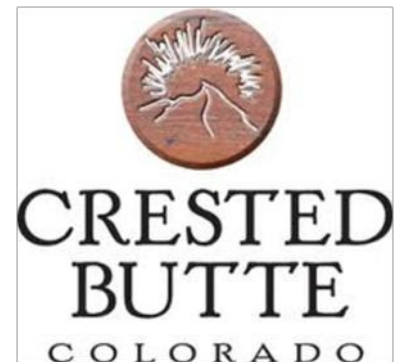
