TRY OUT SONY'S NEW ACTION CAM IN CRESTED BUTTE

Crested Butte Mountain Resort has signed a partnership agreement with Sony Action Cam to launch a loaner program in the base area giving guests the opportunity to experience the Action Cam firsthand. Thursdays—Sundays, Sony Action Cam will have a tent in the resort base area outside the rental & demo shop, with a team who will introduce consumers to the Action Cam and provide free loaner cameras for use on the ski slopes and throughout the resort. Each camera is installed with a 5-minute SD card. When the guest returns the camera, the onsite crew will upload the footage and email it to each user, so they can share their Crested Butte experience with their friends, family and the world through Action Cam's and CBMR's social media platforms @ActionCam and @skicrestedbutte with #ActionCam and www.sony.com/actioncam.

Copper Mountain - we enjoyed 12" of new powder

Thirty-six CSC members enjoyed our first trip of the season to Copper Mountain December 12-15. This was the Club's first-ever December trip to Copper and our last trip there was for FSA in January 2009. Our condos in Center Village were a short walk from two lifts.

After a good first day of skiing with around a 28" base and about 80% of the mountain open, Copper Mountain Resort provided our Club and Omaha's Club a dinner of gourmet pizza and Caesar salad. Chris Lohry's roommate, Kathy Spahr, got her a to-go container as Chris suffered an unfortunate injury mid-morning and couldn't venture out. Chris flew home the next day knowing she'd probably be facing knee surgery. We've since learned she will have ACL MCL reconstruction and repair of a complex medial meniscus tear on January 8 – please keep Chris in your thoughts! She's been our FSA trip's race chair, but we won't be seeing her in Crested Butte this season.

Sunday and Monday were the best ski days, with 7" of fresh powder on top of groomed runs on Sunday and another 5" of powder on Monday. We loaded the bus around 5 on Monday to head back home, arriving in Lincoln around 4:15 a.m. Tuesday morning.

We were pleased to welcome two new CSC members on this trip: **Chris Allen** and **Ben Smith**, both from Lincoln. Eleven days before our trip departure, Ben found the Ski Club through a Google search. We hope to see them both on future CSC trips.

Mt. Bachelor - Bend, Oregon February 21-28, 2015 Fly-out trip — \$1,450

The Cornhusker Ski Club is joining with the Omaha Ski Club as we team up with the Chicago Metropolitan Ski Council (CMSC) for a great week at the Sunriver resort.

This trip includes:
