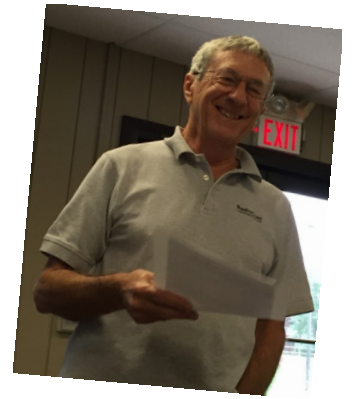
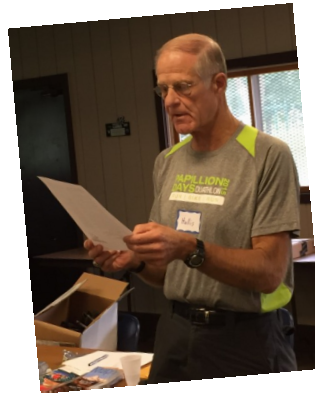


CSC's Breakfast in the Park

SNOWMASS SKI TRIP INFO—
SKI DATES DECEMBER 9 – 14, 2015

DATES: Depart Wednesday evening, December 9, on Windstar Lines. Load at 5:30 p.m.; depart at 6:00 p.m.

SKI DATES: Thursday, December 10 – Sunday, December 13, 2015.

RETURN: Load bus at 4:00 p.m. and depart at 4:30 p.m. We will eat supper in Frisco. Return to Lincoln early Monday morning, December 14.

CONDO -- Tamarack Townhomes: We have contracted for minimum occupancy in seven two-bedroom, 2-bath units and two three-bedroom, 3-bath units for 40 people. The complex has a pool and two hot tubs. These units are right across the street from the lower base area of Snowmass. The 6-chair is located at this base area. The gondola is also within walking distance that travels towards the Elk Camp area. A 4- person foot traffic lift (“Skittles”) takes us to the Village Mall where many restaurants and shopping are located.

LIFT TICKETS: A 3-day lift ticket to ALL four Aspen MOUNTAINS is included in the price of the trip. A 4th day lift is available for \$50.00 and must be ordered before the trip. No senior discounts.

WELCOME PARTY/PIZZA PARTY: Our traditional pizza party will be held the first night.

LOCAL TRANSPORTATION & GROCERIES: A Village shuttle stop is right by the condos, and the free bus service to the other mountains and Aspen is just across the street. A grocery store is within walking distance.

TRIP PRICES: \$525.00 which includes transportation, lodging, 3-day lift ticket, bus beverages and welcome party. Single bunks may be available for \$80.00--put your name on the list when you make your trip deposit.

Payment schedule: \$250.00 deposit, \$275.00 by the October 20 monthly CSC meeting. No lift ticket trip cost: \$375.00.

PLEASE NOTE: There are only two places left on the bus for this trip.

Telluride—
FSA January 19-25, 2016

The trip is filling up fast. We have a few more spaces available.

After skiing just one day last March, Telluride became my new favorite ski area. The skiing, the views, the condo and the town are just awesome. We'll be there from Wednesday, January 20 through Sunday the 24. The bus leaves at 4:30 on Tuesday the 19 and returns early Monday morning the 25. A four day lift ticket is included in the price with a fifth day optional for only \$28.

There will be a wine and cheese and pizza welcome party on Wednesday evening. The Bear Creek Lodge has a heated pool, two hot tubs, a fitness center and sauna. We can accommodate 36 people in 2 bedroom, 2 bath units at Bear Creek and have another 14 similar available spots in nearby condos. If we fill Bear Creek from the bus we'll tend to put drive/fly outs in the other condos since they'll have cars. We will be just a few blocks from the lifts and a very good grocery store. The condo provides an on-call shuttle services that is free and very quick. Getting to downtown Telluride is easy via the gondola which runs until midnight.

Prices: \$920. Add \$28 for a five day lift ticket. Deduct \$210 if you don't want a lift ticket. The initial deposit is \$300, the second \$300 payment is due October 15th and the balance is due November 15th.

The ski club board voted to allow drive/fly outs before the bus is full for this trip only. Deduct \$130 if you provide your own transportation. Some single bunks will be available on the bus for \$80 on a first-come first served basis. It's a long ride to Telluride so a single bunk will be a good option for some.

This is a ski trip the club has wanted to take for years. I'm sure you'll find Telluride as awesome as I did once you make the journey.

CORNHUSKER SKI CLUB TRIP POLICIES

1. When signing up for a trip, a deposit must be given to the Trip Captain with checks payable to the Cornhusker Ski Club, in order to reserve a place on the trip. \$15 of the deposit is non-refundable in the event that you cancel your attendance on the trip for any reason.
2. Once a trip is filled, no deposit is required for you to place your name on a waiting list.
3. The balance of the trip fee is due according to announced schedules. If the Trip Captain does not have your money by this time, your name will be dropped and your reservation will be filled from the waiting list.
4. Cancellations will be accepted by the Trip Captain up to 90 days prior to departure of the trip. If you cancel within 90 days of the trip, your money will be refunded only if your place can be filled from the waiting list. Accommodations, travel and other costs will be refunded only if the reservations can be canceled or rearranged by the Trip Captain.
5. The Cornhusker Ski Club will not be liable for any canceled or altered services, including price increases, not initiated by the Cornhusker Ski Club.
6. Membership in the Cornhusker Ski Club is mandatory for participation in organized trips.
7. Children under 18 who are members with parents, are welcome on trips when accompanied by a responsible adult.
8. On all the trips, the bus will not wait for latecomers on either the trip out or the trip back.
9. Bunk assignments are on a first-come basis, unless stated otherwise by the Trip Captain.
10. No seat swapping is allowed on the bus. The same order of seating en route will be in effect on return unless exception is made by the Trip Captain, with concurrence of all involved.
11. Smoking is prohibited on the buses.
12. Hallucinogens (drugs) and /or marijuana are prohibited. Usage will be grounds for membership dismissal. The same applies to unruly behavior or profanity.
13. Lights out on return after 10:00 p.m., if the next day is a weekday.
14. Trips may be supplemented with drive-outs only on the condition of the bus being filled and that a hardship would not otherwise be imposed on others.
15. Trip Captains will have the final say on any discretionary matters. If there are any complaints, these should be reduced to writing and sent to the overall Trips Chair.
16. Cornhusker Ski Club is not responsible for any personal injury or property damage that may occur during a club organized function. Members assume all legal and financial responsibility for damage to any facilities used by them. If individual responsibility cannot be ascertained, cost of damages will pro-rated among room occupants. Members causing property damage can be dismissed from the club and denied new memberships as stated in the By-Laws.
17. The club is not responsible and shall not be liable for loss of personal property and/or delays or inconveniences sustained by any members or participant in any activity or trip arranged in whole or part by the Cornhusker Ski Club.
18. At Cornhusker Ski Club meetings and functions, members are prohibited from promoting any trips or activities except those organized by the Cornhusker Ski Club.
