**Trip prices:** \$525.00. This trip includes bus  
transportation, lodging, 3-day lift ticket, bus  
beverages and welcome party. Single bunks  
may be available for \$80.00—put your name  
on the single bunk list when you make your  
trip deposit. A 3-day lift ticket is included,  
fourth day optional for \$53.00.

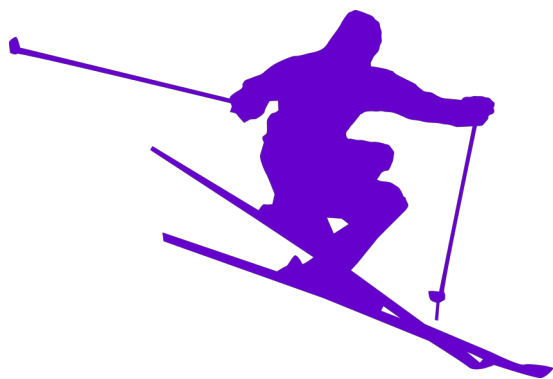
**Condo:** Tamarack Townhomes: CSC is

## More About Snowmass . . .

Snowmass is consistently rated as one of the top destinations by the ski magazines and the lift tickets are interchangeable with the other three mountains in the Aspen, Buttermilk, Aspen Highlands triangle. All are served by 30- minute free bus service with the main bus terminal at Snowmass right across the street from our condos. Aspen Mountain and Aspen Highlands are known for more narrow and steeper runs. Buttermilk is the place to be to enjoy more gentle skiing along with some great snowboarding.



Snowmass is known for its extensive snowmaking coverage and has the reputation as “cruiser heaven” for the large numbers of blue runs, most of which are high on the mountain where the snow is always better. It has a multitude of runs for all abilities. At the end of the day you can use the ski transfer service to have your skis moved to another mountain for the next day for a fee and avoid schlepping your skis with you, freeing you for apres’ ski time—How cool is that!

## **STEAMBOAT—FSA SKI TRIP** **JANUARY 25-29, 2017**

Steamboat is filling quickly...we have 60 members on board to-date and have scrambled to get more rooms! Thanks to all of you who have sent in your deposits. Please continue your payments.

**Dates:** The bus will depart Tuesday evening, January 24. Ski dates will be Wednesday, January 25 – Sunday, January 29. Depart Steamboat Sunday afternoon, January 29 and return to Lincoln early Monday morning, January 30.

**Trip Prices:** \$735.00 for this trip which includes bus, four nights lodging at minimum occupancy condo, 4-day lift ticket, FSA activity ticket to include racing, activities, two evening meals, bus beverages and club pizza party. Single bunks may be available for \$80.00—put your name on the bunk list when you make your deposit. OPTION: If you don’t need a lift ticket: \$500.00. FLY/DRIVE OUT OPTION: Again this year, we are offering fly/drive out option at \$600. This price includes all of the trip except transportation.

**Lift Ticket:** A 4-day lift ticket is included but there are options. 5<sup>th</sup> day lift: add \$40.00 to trip price. Ask about other options that you need. No senior discount.

**Condo:** Minimum occupancy at Torian Plum Creekside, a premier ski-in/ski-out. We will have 10 2-bedroom+den/2-bath units and one 2-bedroom/2-bath unit.

Steamboat offers trails ranging from beginner (14%), intermediate (42%) to advanced (44%) so there is something for everyone to ski along with the races FSA is offering. There are also terrain parks for all levels of boarding. If you are not inclined to ski or board, try cross country trails (114 miles) or snowshoes (7 miles of trails). There is also night skiing/riding offered Thursday - Monday if you haven't got your vertical in!

Don't forget your cowboy boots for dancing with the FSA clubs! Other entertainment may be the hot springs (Old Town Hot Springs or Strawberry Park Hot Springs), sleigh rides, hot air balloon rides or snowmobiling.

Steamboat Ski Resort is a very popular resort for our club and we meet the other FSA trips for our annual racing and party events. The base sits at 6,900 feet with the summit of Mt. Werner at 10,568 feet so a friendly altitude for those with altitude issues. The skiing ranges from groomed runs for all ability levels to the legendary champagne powder snow in the trees for those powder hounds.

The Cornhuskers are in charge of FSA activities at Steamboat and club member Teresa Ingram stepped up to take the reins. Teresa has been working with the FSA board & Steamboat staff to prepare the week's fun for all the FSA clubs. Please let her know that you are available to help.

The Torian Plum Creekside Condos are an upgrade for our ski club. Previous years found us at Ski Inn but the property was recently dropped by the group managing our contract. They offered us an upgrade and we snatched the opportunity!

The Torian Plum Creekside Condos are Steamboat's premier ski-in/ski-out lodging. The Torian Plum Creekside building is located on the east side of the Torian Plum Resort. The building sits slope side along the Christie Peak chairlift and 100 yards from the gondola.

These luxury condos are nestled amidst the shops and restaurants in the Torian Plaza, including Café Diva and Slopeside and just a short walk on the new promenade to the Gondola Square area with more restaurant, shopping and ski resort amenities. Downtown Steamboat is ten minutes away—and a shuttle will chauffeur guests around Steamboat during our stay. Condos have balconies, gas fireplaces, fully-equipped kitchens and spacious living rooms. Enjoy the outdoor heated pool, indoor and outdoor hot tubs, sauna and fitness room.

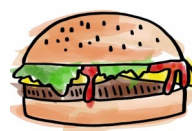

### CORNHUSKER SKI CLUB TRIP POLICIES

1. When signing up for a trip, a deposit must be given to the Trip Captain with checks payable to the Cornhusker Ski Club, in order to reserve a place on the trip. \$15 of the deposit is non-refundable in the event that you cancel your attendance on the trip for any reason.
2. Once a trip is filled, no deposit is required for you to place your name on a waiting list.
3. The balance of the trip fee is due according to announced schedules. If the Trip Captain does not have your money by this time, your name will be dropped and your reservation will be filled from the waiting list.
4. Cancellations will be accepted by the Trip Captain up to 90 days prior to departure of the trip. If you cancel within 90 days of the trip, your money will be refunded only if your place can be filled from the waiting list. Accommodations, travel and other costs will be refunded only if the reservations can be canceled or rearranged by the Trip Captain.
5. The Cornhusker Ski Club will not be liable for any canceled or altered services, including price increases, not initiated by the Cornhusker Ski Club.
6. Membership in the Cornhusker Ski Club is mandatory for participation in organized trips.
7. Children under 18 who are members with parents, are welcome on trips when accompanied by a responsible adult.
8. On all the trips, the bus will not wait for latecomers on either the trip out or the trip back.
9. Bunk assignments are on a first-come basis, unless stated otherwise by the Trip Captain.
10. No seat swapping is allowed on the bus. The same order of seating en route will be in effect on return unless exception is made by the Trip Captain, with concurrence of all involved.
11. Smoking is prohibited on the buses.
12. Hallucinogens (drugs) and /or marijuana are prohibited. Usage will be grounds for membership dismissal. The same applies to unruly behavior or profanity.
13. Lights out on return after 10:00 p.m., if the next day is a weekday.
14. Trips may be supplemented with drive-outs only on the condition of the bus being filled and that a hardship would not otherwise be imposed on others.
15. Trip Captains will have the final say on any discretionary matters. If there are any complaints, these should be reduced to writing and sent to the overall Trips Chair.
16. Cornhusker Ski Club is not responsible for any personal injury or property damage that may occur during a club organized function. Members assume all legal and financial responsibility for damage to any facilities used by them. If individual responsibility cannot be ascertained, cost of damages will pro-rated among room occupants. Members causing property damage can be dismissed from the club and denied new memberships as stated in the By-Laws.
17. The club is not responsible and shall not be liable for loss of personal property and/or delays or inconveniences sustained by any members or participant in any activity or trip arranged in whole or part by the Cornhusker Ski Club.
18. At Cornhusker Ski Club meetings and functions, members are prohibited from promoting any trips or activities except those organized by the Cornhusker Ski Club.
