

### SNOWMASS and The Power of Four Mountains in One Lift Ticket

Snowmass is less than a month away and the snow guns along with the snow gods are working hard to make our first trip of the year a success. Our trip leaving the evening of Wednesday, December 7 still has some openings so get on board now! You will also want to contact the trip captain to reserve your solo bunk for a mere \$80 roundtrip.

This will give you an opportunity to be fresh and ready to start Thursday on the slopes. There are still 14 spots open on the bus.

Your trip includes a 3 day lift ticket (with a possible 4th day for \$53.00), 3 nights lodging in Tamarack Condos across from the lifts, sleeper bus accommodations for the ride to Colorado from Lincoln, pizza party the first evening, and an opportunity to dine in Aspen on your own with the finest. No pre-trip party this trip due to the holidays so watch your email for your information sheet coming later this month.

**Dates:** The bus departs from Lincoln Wednesday evening, December 7, at 6:00 p.m. and will return early Monday morning, December 12. Ski days are Thursday, December 8 – Sunday, December 11.

**Trip prices:** \$525.00. This trip includes bus transportation, lodging, 3-day lift ticket, bus beverages and welcome party. <u>Single bunks</u> may be available for \$80.00—put your name on the single bunk list when you make your trip deposit. A 3-day lift ticket is included, fourth day optional for \$53.00.

### STEAMBOAT—FSA SKI TRIP JANUARY 25-29, 2017

Steamboat is filling quickly...we have 60 members on board to-date and have scrambled to get more rooms! Thanks to all of you who have sent in your deposits. Please continue your payments.

**Dates:** The bus will depart Tuesday evening, January 24. Ski dates will be Wednesday, January 25 – Sunday, January 29. Depart Steamboat Sunday afternoon, January 29 and return to Lincoln early Monday morning, January 30.

**Trip Prices:** \$735.00 for this trip which includes bus, four nights lodging at minimum occupancy condo, 4-day lift ticket, FSA activity ticket to include racing, activities, two evening meals, bus beverages and club pizza party. Single bunks may be available for \$80.00—put your name on the bunk list when you make your deposit. OPTION: If you don't need a lift ticket: \$500.00. FLY/DRIVE OUT OPTION: Again this year, we are offering fly/drive out option at \$600. This price includes all of the trip except transportation.

**Lift Ticket:** A 4-day lift ticket is included but there are options. 5<sup>th</sup> day lift: add \$40.00 to trip price. Ask about other options that you need. No senior discount.

**Condo:** Minimum occupancy at Torian Plum Creekside, a premier ski-in/ski-out. We will have 10 2-bedroom+den/2-bath units and one 2-bedroom/2-bath unit.

**Payment Schedule:** \$200.00 initial deposit, \$250.00 October 18 payment, remainder due at November 15 meeting.

Steamboat offers trails ranging from beginner (14%), intermediate (42%) to advanced (44%) so there is something for everyone to ski along with the races FSA is offering. There are also terrain parks for all levels of boarding. If you are not inclined to ski or board, try cross country trails (114 miles) or snowshoes (7 miles of trails). There is also night skiing/riding offered Thursday - Monday if you haven't got your vertical in!

Don't forget your cowboy boots for dancing with the FSA clubs! Other entertainment may be the hot springs (Old Town Hot Springs or Strawberry Park Hot Springs), sleigh rides, hot air balloon rides or snowmobiling.

Steamboat Ski Resort is a very popular resort for our club and we meet the other FSA trips for our annual racing and party events. The base sits at 6,900 feet with the summit of Mt. Werner at 10,568 feet so a friendly altitude for those with altitude issues. The skiing ranges from groomed runs for all ability levels to the legendary champagne powder snow in the trees for those powder hounds.

The Cornhuskers are in charge of FSA activities at Steamboat and club member Teresa Ingram stepped up to take the reins. Teresa has been working with the FSA board & Steamboat staff to prepare the week's fun for all the FSA clubs. Please let her know that you are available to help.

Raspberry Women's fit LONG-sleeve shirt has narrower ribbed collar, looser neck style, no ribbed cuffs on sleeves. Women's Fit generally runs 1-2 sizes smaller than Unisex.

This FSA-members-only open race provides you with more options to get a medal. **NEW:** Rather than signing up the morning of the race, we are offering advance sign-up and payment through Nick McElvain. The cost is \$20.00, and advance sign-up and payment through your Club's FSA trip captain is needed **by Friday, December 23.** On the day of the Open Race, you can still sign-up for the same \$20.00 cost (location/time TBD) and your racing position will be **after** those who were in the advance sign-up lottery.

After a fun-filled morning of the final race match-ups and skiing, why not meet at the Bashor Picnic Area for an FSA-members-only on-mountain picnic? #### CORNHUSKER SKI CLUB TRIP POLICIES

- 1. When signing up for a trip, a deposit must be given to the Trip Captain with checks payable to the Cornhusker Ski Club, in order to reserve a place on the trip. \$15 of the deposit is non-refundable in the event that you cancel your attendance on the trip for any reason.
- Once a trip is filled, no deposit is required for you to place your name on a waiting list.
- The balance of the trip fee is due according to announced schedules. If the Trip Captain does not have your money by this time, your name will be dropped and your reservation will be filled from the waiting list.
- 4. Cancellations will be accepted by the Trip Captain up to 90 days prior to departure of the trip. If you cancel within 90 days of the trip, your money will be refunded only if your place can be filled from the waiting list. Accommodations, travel and other costs will be refunded only if the reservations can be canceled or rearranged by the Trip Captain.
- The Cornhusker Ski Club will not be liable for any canceled or altered services, including price increases, not initiated by the Cornhusker Ski Club.
- Membership in the Cornhusker Ski Club is mandatory for participation in organized trips.
- Children under 18 who are members with parents, are welcome on trips when accompanied by a responsible adult.
- On all the trips, the bus will not wait for latecomers on either the trip out or the trip back.
- Bunk assignments are on a first-come basis, unless stated otherwise by the Trip Captain.
- 10. No seat swapping is allowed on the bus. The same order

- of seating en route will be in effect on return unless exception is made by the Trip Captain, with concurrence of all involved.
- 11. Smoking is prohibited on the buses.
- Hallucinogens (drugs) and /or marijuana are prohibited.
   Usage will be grounds for membership dismissal. The same applies to unruly behavior or profanity.
- 13. Lights out on return after 10:00 p.m., if the next day is a weekday.
- 14. Trips may be supplemented with drive-outs only on the condition of the bus being filled and that a hardship would not otherwise be imposed on others.
- 15. Trip Captains will have the final say on any discretionary matters. If there are any complaints, these should be reduced to writing and sent to the overall Trips Chair.
- 16. Cornhusker Ski Club is not responsible for any personal injury or property damage that may occur during a club organized function. Members assume all legal and financial responsibility for damage to any facilities used by them. If individual responsibility cannot be ascertained, cost of damages will pro-rated among room occupants. Members causing property damage can be dismissed from the club and denied new memberships as stated in the By-Laws.
- 17. The club is not responsible and shall not be liable for loss of personal property and/or delays or inconveniences sustained by any members or participant in any activity or trip arranged in whole or part by the Cornhusker Ski Club.
- 18. At Cornhusker Ski Club meetings and functions, members are prohibited from promoting any trips or activities except those organized by the Cornhusker Ski Club.
