The Cornhuskers performed very well at Snowmass, finishing 2 points out of third place. That was the closest we have been to third place in many years. Thank you to everyone who participated as everyone contributes points.

The Cornhusker snowshoe A Team Relay started off the scoring on Thursday afternoon by placing second for the FSA Silver medals. Mike Williams led off, followed by Laura Williams, then Dan Griffith and anchor Derek McElvain. The Cornhusker B team finished with the 7th best time out of ten. B team members were Henry Rohla, Kirsten Simpson, Carl Roemer and Jon Springer.

Mid-day Thursday was the open ski race with Mike Williams earning a Gold medal with Chris Lohry and Tom Starr both earning Silver medals.

Friday morning was the FSA Challenge race. Wayne started our club off winning 1st and Dave Camper coming in 2nd in their age group. Mike Williams earned 3rd in his age group, Tom Starr finished 2nd in his age group, Jon Morgan earned 2nd in his age group, Jeremy Wilson earned 1st in his age group, and Derek McElvain finished 2nd in his age group. For the women, Chris Lohry finished 1st and Patsy Meyer 2nd in their age group. First in her age group was Jennifer Simpson. 
