DATES: Depart Wednesday **MORNING**, **December 11. Load at 7:30 a.m.**, depart at 8:00 a.m. on Windstar Lines VIP bus.

NEW FREEBIE FOR BUS RIDERS! We will pick up pre-ordered box lunches from Subway in Lexington so we can keep the wheels rolling instead of taking a lunch break. Teresa will be in touch with all bus riders about the free lunch pre-order form.

SKI DATES: Thursday, December 12 – Sunday, December 15, 2019

RETURN: Load bus on Sunday, December 15, at 4:00 p.m. and depart at 4:30 p.m. We'll stop at Eagle for fast food on the way home and arrive in Lincoln early Monday morning, December 16.

BASIC TRIP PRICE:

• \$500.00: includes bus transportation, lodging, bus beverages and welcome party.

ADD-ON LIFT TICKETS: A lift ticket to ALL 4 MOUNTAINS is available for the trip. Two levels of lift tickets:

- Regular = 3-day is \$204; 4-day is \$272.
- Senior 65+ rate = 3-day is \$129; 4-day is \$172.

CONDO – Tamarack Townhomes: Located right across the street from the lower base area of Snowmass. The 6-chair lift is located at this base area. The gondola is also within walking distance that travels towards the Elk Camp area. A 4-person foot traffic lift ("Skittles") takes us to the Village Mall where many restaurants and shopping are located. Ski rental is also in the lower base area.

Steamboat Springs Ski Resort had so much powder last year FSA decided to hit the slopes again this year for our annual FSA trip. Steamboat sure did live up to their "claim to fame" of having Champagne Powder! The mountain has around 3,000 acres of terrain with lots of diversity for skiers and boarders of all levels. Steamboat is family friendly, **lower in altitude**, plus great food and drinks! Their annual snowfall is around 336 inches and we will be in the snow globe. There are only a few spots available on this trip.

DATES: Depart Tuesday, January 21, 2020, on Windstar Lines. Load in Lincoln at 7:00 p.m., depart at 7:30p.m. We will ski Wednesday through Sunday and return early Monday morning, January 27. (Add your name to a list for an available single bunk for \$80.00 round trip). Bus will load Sunday at 3:30 p.m. and depart at 4:00 p.m. with a stop along the way for a quick fast-food dinner.

CONDOS: We will be staying four nights at Ski-Inn. Skiers can ski to the condo but will need to walk out or ride the shuttle. There will be a club pizza party the first night.

TRIP PRICES (without lift tickets): \$600.00 includes bus, 4 nights lodging, bus beverages, FSA activities and pizza party. Subtract \$160 if you are drive/fly out.

LIFT TICKETS: A 4-day lift is available for \$276.00 with a 5th day optional for \$49.00. No Senior Discount. Other options are available, i.e. 3-day, etc. Subtract \$69.00 from 4-day trip price for each day less. If you have an **Ikon Pass** there maybe some changes this year so please email or text Jenny with your number.

FSA ACTIVITIES: Meals & dancing will be offered on Thursday and Saturday evenings with free beer from our Boulevard sponsor.

For this year's FSA races there are two new categories. The first is for women that would like to race on a more difficult race course. They can opt to race on the same course as the men as part of the earlier morning men's group. At Steamboat this means starting from the higher start which is the same start as used for the Thursday optional Open race. All entrants will be ranked based on best handicap on the two courses with no age brackets or handicap adjustments. The top 3 will be recognized and it will be scored the same as any other bracket.

The second new category is for men who want to race a less difficult course and not racing from the higher start at Steamboat. Like the above example they will run with the afternoon women's brackets as a separate category. They will be scored and recognized as one combined group based on handicap with no age adjustments.

If you are interested in switching to either of these new options please advise Hollis as race director so you are seeded in the group you choose. Otherwise, you will be entered in the challenge race in your age category. You may also be interested in the snowshoe races.....Cornhusker's have both an A & B team.

The Copper Mountain trip is FULL. With such interest in this trip we may look at the possibility of adding another condo if we have at least two more skiers. Please contact Tom Becker (trip captain) as soon as possible. It's the time of the ski season when Colorado typically gets some big snow dumps so skiing should be fantastic! Our condos are at the main mountain village within a few minutes walk of the American Eagle/Flyer express lifts.

Our condos are 2-bedroom, 2-bath units with minimum occupancy (4 people per condo) and we have reserved pillows for 24 skiers/boarders.

Jo Morris from Lexington and Deb Brown from Lincoln are looking for a ride to Copper and back. If you have room in your vehicle please contact them.

DATES: Check in Sunday, March 1st (after 4:00 p.m.) with checkout Wednesday morning, March 4th. This will allow drivers to stay in Denver Saturday night to acclimate if they choose, driving to Copper Sunday to ski if desired. Copper would not allow us to check in on Saturday as Sunday is their change over day. We will have two change rooms on the back end of the trip only. Lodging for Wednesday evening can be added for \$45 person using the change rooms.

COST: \$325 for three nights lodging at Center Village AND pizza party!! Base price does **NOT** include lift tickets as a number of members have purchased various season passes. At this time we are no longer taking deposits and any balances for the trip are due by the November 19 monthly meeting.

LIFT TICKETS: 2-day: \$137, 3-day: \$203, 4-day: \$269. Lift ticket orders and payment are due by Monday, January 6, 2020.

TRIP INSURANCE

It's been said that trip insurance is never needed until it's needed. What should you know about trip insurance?

- You must purchase trip insurance coverage <u>before</u> it is needed. Once you recognize the need, it is too late to protect your trip.
- After the initial trip payment is made and you have a good grasp of your total expected trip cost, it is good time to get the most accurate quote.
- An example of coverage for a \$1,500 trip within the United States for a 60-year-old is approximately \$63 through <u>www.insuremytrip.com</u>.
- If you need coverage for a pre-existing medical condition, there are time-sensitive eligibility
 requirements tied to your initial trip payment and you may have a limited amount of time to buy a
 plan.

CORNHUSKER SKI CLUB TRIP POLICIES

- Membership is mandatory to participate in trips organized by the Cornhusker Ski Club. A completed and signed Cornhusker Ski Club membership form must be submitted with membership dues payable to Cornhusker Ski Club.
- To reserve a place on the trip, a deposit must be given to the Trip Captain with checks payable to the Cornhusker Ski Club. \$15 of the deposit is non-refundable in the event that you cancel your participation on the trip for any reason.
- The balance of the trip fee is due according to announced schedules. If the Trip Captain does not have payment by these dates, your name will be dropped and your reservation filled from the waiting list.
- Once a trip is filled, no deposit is required to place your name on a waiting list.
- 5. Trip cancellations or changes will be accepted by the Trip Captain up to 90 days <u>prior</u> to trip departure. Cancellations or changes <u>within</u> 90 days of the trip departure will be refunded only if you find a replacement, or if the Trip Captain can fill your place from the waiting list. Refunds are subject to the \$15 non-refundable deposit. **Purchasing** individual trip insurance is recommended.
- The Cornhusker Ski Club will not be liable for any canceled or altered services, including price increases, not initiated by the Cornhusker Ski Club.
- Children under 18 who are members with parents, are welcome on trips when accompanied by a responsible adult.
- On all the trips, the bus will not wait for latecomers on either the trip out or the trip back.
- 9. Bunk assignments are on a first-come basis, unless stated otherwise by the Trip Captain.

- 10. No seat swapping is allowed on the bus. The same order of seating en route will be in effect on return unless exception is made by the Trip Captain, with concurrence of all involved.
- 11. Smoking is prohibited on the buses.
- Hallucinogens (drugs) and /or marijuana are prohibited. Usage will be grounds for membership dismissal. The same applies to unruly behavior or profanity.
- Lights out on return after 10:00 p.m., if the next day is a weekday.
- 14. Trips may be supplemented with drive-outs only on the condition of the bus being filled and that a hardship would not otherwise be imposed on others.
- 15. Trip Captains will have the final say on any discretionary matters. If there are any complaints, these should be reduced to writing and sent to the overall Trips Chair.
- 16. Cornhusker Ski Club is not responsible for any personal injury or property damage that may occur during a club organized function. Members assume all legal and financial responsibility for damage to any facilities used by them. If individual responsibility cannot be ascertained, cost of damages will pro-rated among room occupants. Members causing property damage can be dismissed from the club and denied new memberships as stated in the By-Laws.
- 17. The club is not responsible and shall not be liable for loss of personal property and/or delays or inconveniences sustained by any members or participant in any activity or trip arranged in whole or part by the Cornhusker Ski Club.
- At Cornhusker Ski Club meetings and functions, members are prohibited from promoting any trips or activities except
