CSC's 2022-2023 Ski Destinations

Hello ski clubbers and we hope your start of summer is going well. Just in case you were not at the last meeting here is a lineup of our trips booked for next season. Early booking was required, and rates are up. Based on your suggestions and availability we have booked the following resorts and times. Pricing will be out prior to the August event in the park and sign up for the first trip will be necessary for guaranteed spots on the December trip. Here is what we have booked. This season you will provide your own transportation for all trips - drive/fly/train.

Snowmass - December 11-16 (Sunday-Friday)

Returning to Snowmass and Tamarack Condos with a 5-night stay arriving Sunday afternoon. Either fly, drive or take the train to Glenwood Springs and ride the public bus to Snowmass. If you haven't stayed at



the property, it is easy walking distance from the base area and close to the bus transfer to Aspen and Aspen Highlands which are included on our lift tickets. Scheduled to stay away from weekend crowds with easy access to many restaurants and walking or bus distance to a good grocery store.

FSA Whitefish – January 27 – February 3 (Friday-Friday)

The usual FSA activities return with a trip to Whitefish, Montana, which is the gateway to Glacier National Park. Our lodging is 7 nights, and our condos are right around the base area of the Mountain. There are lots of options for your off days including a day skiing at Fernie in Canada or snowshoe/snowmobile adventures in the area. Jennifer Simpson is the trip captain for your FSA adventure.



Copper Mountain – February 26 – March 3 (Sunday-Friday)

Our third trip returns us once again to Copper Mountain. We have 5-night lodging in Center Village where we have been staying the last several years, an easy walking distance to the lifts. Our lodging starts Sunday. 2/26. which keeps us out of the mess that is skiing Summit County on Friday-Sunday. This typically is some of the best snow conditions of the season, so put the date on your calendar.

CORNHUSKER SKI CLUB TRIP POLICIES

- Membership is mandatory to participate in trips organized by the Cornhusker Ski Club. A completed and signed Cornhusker Ski Club membership form must be submitted with membership dues payable to Cornhusker Ski Club.
- 2. To reserve a place on the trip, a deposit must be given to the Trip Captain with checks payable to the Cornhusker Ski Club. \$15 of the deposit is non-refundable in the event that you cancel your participation on the trip for any reason.
- The balance of the trip fee is due according to announced schedules. If the Trip Captain does not have payment by these dates, your name will be dropped and your reservation filled from the waiting list.
- Once a trip is filled, no deposit is required to place your name on a waiting list.
- 5. Trip cancellations or changes will be accepted by the Trip Captain up to 90 days <u>prior</u> to trip departure. Cancellations or changes <u>within</u> 90 days of the trip departure will be refunded only if you find a replacement, or if the Trip Captain can fill your place from the waiting list. Refunds are subject to the \$15 non-refundable deposit. Purchasing individual trip insurance is recommended.
- The Cornhusker Ski Club will not be liable for any canceled or altered services, including price increases, not initiated by the Cornhusker Ski Club.
- Children under 18 who are members with parents, are welcome on trips when accompanied by a responsible adult.
- On all the trips, the bus will not wait for latecomers on either the trip out or the trip back.
- Bunk assignments are on a first-come basis, unless stated otherwise by the Trip Captain.

- No seat swapping is allowed on the bus. The same order of seating en route will be in effect on return unless exception is made by the Trip Captain, with concurrence of all involved.
- 11. Smoking is prohibited on the buses.
- Hallucinogens (drugs) and /or marijuana are prohibited.
 Usage will be grounds for membership dismissal. The same applies to unruly behavior or profanity.
- 13. Lights out on return after 10:00 p.m., if the next day is a weekday.
- 14. Trips may be supplemented with drive-outs only on the condition of the bus being filled and that a hardship would not otherwise be imposed on others.
- 15. Trip Captains will have the final say on any discretionary matters. If there are any complaints, these should be reduced to writing and sent to the overall Trips Chair.
- 16. Cornhusker Ski Club is not responsible for any personal injury or property damage that may occur during a club organized function. Members assume all legal and financial responsibility for damage to any facilities used by them. If individual responsibility cannot be ascertained, cost of damages will pro-rated among room occupants. Members causing property damage can be dismissed from the club and denied new memberships as stated in the By-Laws.
- 17. The club is not responsible and shall not be liable for loss of personal property and/or delays or inconveniences sustained by any members or participant in any activity or trip arranged in whole or part by the Cornhusker Ski Club.
- At Cornhusker Ski Club meetings and functions, members are prohibited from promoting any trips or activities except those organized by the Cornhusker Ski Club.

Cornhusker Ski Club Covid Policy. Effective 8.29.21

To participate in CSC sponsored ski trips, the policies regarding the current COVID 19 outbreak

Provided Bus Transportation

- All passengers on the bus must have a current fully-vaccinated Covid card
- Passengers on the bus will <u>not be</u> required by CSC to wear a mask the bus company may implement masks requirements prior to departure.
- Masks may be worn by individuals who desire additional protection
- CSC anticipates that youth vaccinations will be available prior to this years trips
- Unvaccinated participants will need to arrange for their own transportation to the ski area

Provided Lodging

- Unvaccinated participants will be required to provide proof of a negative Covid test within 72 hours of their expected arrival at the lodging site - persons testing positive will be excluded from the trip
- Unvaccinated participants will also need to make arrangements with other participants (vaccinated or unvaccinated) to share a condo with. The expense for empty beds in a given condo will be the financial responsibility of the unvaccinated participant.
- Your trip captain may be able to help identify other unvaccinated participants for you to coordinate with.

Cornhusker Ski Club

- Vaccinated participants must send a photo or scanned copy of their vaccination card to the membership chair - csc.ne.membership@gmail.com
- CSC will store this information along with other membership information, and will advise trip captains which participants have a vaccination card.
- CSC will monitor local health mandates, and advise members as information becomes available.
- CSC advises all members to consider Trip Insurance in the event that a Covid infection or test results in being unable to attend a trip.

WAIVER/RELEASE FOR COMMUNICABLE DISEASES INCLUDING COVID-19

The novel coronavirus, COVID-19 has been declared a worldwide pandemic by the World Health Organization. **COVID-19 is extremely contagious** and is believed to spread mainly from person-to-person contact. As a result, federal, state and local governments and federal and state health agencies recommend social distancing and have, in many locations, prohibited the congregation of groups of people.

- 4. Releasor on behalf of him/herself and on behalf of Releasor's heirs, assigns, personal representatives and next of kin, hereby releases and holds harmless the Cornhusker Ski Club its officers, officials, agents, and/or employees, other participants, sponsoring agencies, sponsors, advertisers, volunteers and if applicable, owners and lessors of premises used to conduct the event, ("Releasees") with respect to any and all illness, disability, death, or loss or damage to person or property, whether arising from the negligence of releasees or otherwise, to the fullest extent permitted by law.
