CHANGES WE'LL SEE FOR THE COMING SEASON OF SKI TRIPS

Summertime and the days are busy as we get outside to enjoy the season. We hope you are having an active and enjoyable summer. We also want you to think about your winter plans as the resorts are locking in pricing and availability.

Cornhusker Ski Club is having to modify trip pricing and availability as lodging has moved more to the VRBO model and group lift tickets are becoming a thing of the past with more multi-resort pass options becoming standard. Lodging companies require larger deposits and there is less flexibility on cancellation. We are updating you with the changes in our club trip policies made necessary by the changes currently occurring in the ski industry.

Cornhusker Ski Club will no longer have early sign-up pricing discounts. All trips will show the trip price and the number of pillows available. The first members with deposits to the trip captain get the spots at that price. If more members sign up than we have on the current contract, we will explore additional lodging and determine the add-on price at

that time. There is no guarantee that we can get additional space, but we will look at available options in hopes we can accommodate additional travelers.

Many of you have Ikon passes and all trips this coming season are under that system. **Read the details of our 2023-2024 trips on page 3, then contact the trip captains and mail the required deposits ASAP if you want a spot on any of the trips.**

Please read all the club policies on the membership form as the cancellation policy has **not** changed. All the trips have very convenient lodgings by the slopes. Skiers/boarders can't wait for September or October any more to decide where to play in the winter, but think of the fun you will have when you get there.

We look forward to seeing you at the membership kick-off at the end of August or the first meeting in September. Don't wait to sign up and find out you may not get on the trip!

TRIP INSURANCE

It's been said that trip insurance is never needed until it's needed.
What should you know about trip insurance?

- You must purchase trip insurance coverage before it is needed. Once you recognize the need, it is too late to protect your trip.
- After the initial trip payment is made and you have a good grasp of your total expected trip cost, it is good time to get the most accurate quote.
- An example of coverage for a \$1,500 trip within the United States for a 60-year-old is approximately \$63 through www.insuremytrip.com.
- If you need coverage for a pre-existing medical condition, there are time-sensitive eligibility requirements tied to your initial trip payment and you may have a limited amount of time to buy a plan.

Lodging: Two-bedroom condos are reserved at Ski Inn Condos for **28** participants. We stayed at Ski Inn our last visit to Steamboat. The condos are more ski-in than ski-out.

Cost: **\$970.00** for 6 nights lodging and the FSA activity ticket for racing and 2 dinner buffets. The dinners will be full buffets (no potato bars!) at Thunderhead and will include choices of meats and vegetables. Transportation is on your own. Consider carpooling.

CORNHUSKER SKI CLUB TRIP POLICIES

1. Membership is mandatory to participate in trips organized by the Cornhusker Ski Club. A completed and signed Cornhusker Ski Club membership form must be submitted with membership dues payable to Cornhusker Ski Club.
2. To reserve a place on the trip, a deposit must be given to the Trip Captain with checks payable to the Cornhusker Ski Club. \$15 of the deposit is non-refundable in the event that you cancel your participation on the trip for any reason.
3. The balance of the trip fee is due according to announced schedules. If the Trip Captain does not have payment by these dates, your name will be dropped and your reservation filled from the waiting list.
4. Once a trip is filled, no deposit is required to place your name on a waiting list.
5. Trip cancellations or changes will be accepted by the Trip Captain up to 90 days prior to trip departure. Cancellations or changes within 90 days of the trip departure will be refunded only if you find a replacement, or if the Trip Captain can fill your place from the waiting list. Refunds are subject to the \$15 non-refundable deposit. **Purchasing individual trip insurance is recommended.**
6. The Cornhusker Ski Club will not be liable for any canceled or altered services, including price increases, not initiated by the Cornhusker Ski Club.
7. Children under 18 who are members with parents, are welcome on trips when accompanied by a responsible adult.
8. On all the trips, the bus will not wait for latecomers on either the trip out or the trip back.
9. Bunk assignments are on a first-come basis, unless stated otherwise by the Trip Captain.
10. No seat swapping is allowed on the bus. The same order of seating enroute will be in effect on return unless exception is made by the Trip Captain, with concurrence of all involved.
11. Smoking is prohibited on the buses.
12. Hallucinogens (drugs) and /or marijuana are prohibited. Usage will be grounds for membership dismissal. The same applies to unruly behavior or profanity.
13. Lights out on return after 10:00 p.m., if the next day is a weekday.
14. Trips may be supplemented with drive-outs only on the condition of the bus being filled and that a hardship would not otherwise be imposed on others.
15. Trip Captains will have the final say on any discretionary matters. If there are any complaints, these should be reduced to writing and sent to the overall Trips Chair.
16. Cornhusker Ski Club is not responsible for any personal injury or property damage that may occur during a club organized function. Members assume all legal and financial responsibility for damage to any facilities used by them. If individual responsibility cannot be ascertained, cost of damages will pro-rated among room occupants. Members causing property damage can be dismissed from the club and denied new memberships as stated in the By-Laws.
17. The club is not responsible and shall not be liable for loss of personal property and/or delays or inconveniences sustained by any members or participant in any activity or trip arranged in whole or part by the Cornhusker Ski Club.
18. At Cornhusker Ski Club meetings and functions, members are prohibited from promoting any trips or activities except those organized by the Cornhusker Ski Club.
